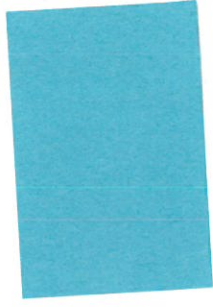


## Mapping Lab Station 1

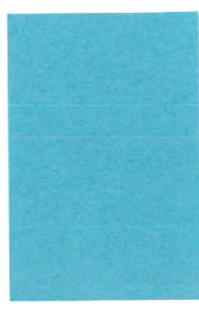
Name four Latin American countries where most of the precious metals (gold, silver, copper) are found.

- Which four countries have the most desert scrub vegetation?

- What seven countries lie southeast of Mexico and northwest of Colombia?
- How is the land used in those seven countries?

- What is the main climate zone of the two largest islands that lie near 20° N latitude?
- Which three countries are located on those two islands?
